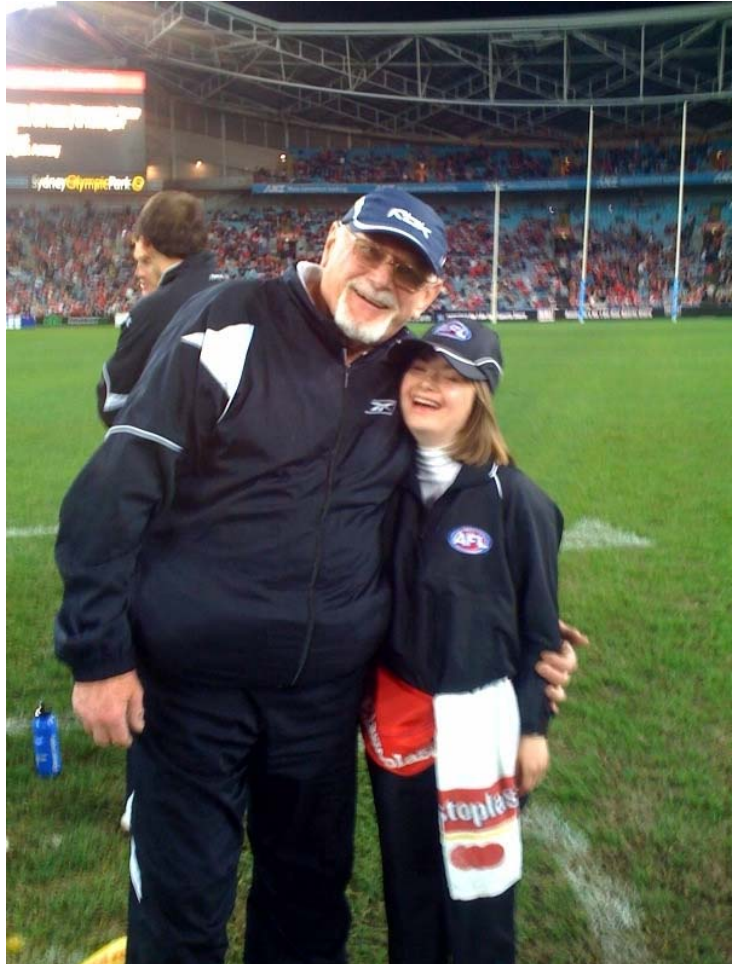




SWANS V GEELONG
